BHMS Performing Arts Boosters Volunteer Opportunities

Volunteering is a great way to be involved while supporting our music and drama programs.

President – Cathy Ebbing

Conducts meetings, develops agendas, works as liaison between the music teachers, committees and parents

Secretary – Open

Records, types and distributes meeting minutes.

Treasurer – Shauna Elias

Collects, records, and disperses monies collected by PAB. Prepares budget, financial reports for meetings. Updates data lists of parent contributions.

Lock-In Chairman/Committee – Open

Assist band and orchestra teachers with one after-school Lock-In before each Solo & Ensemble festival (November & April). Organize snacks and volunteers to support this 3-hour rehearsal for the 15-30 seventh and eighth grade band and orchestra students attending Solo & Ensemble festival.

Outreach Coordinator/Committee –

Schedule dates for students to perform solos or in small groups at local nursing homes, senior centers, hospitals or community venues. Students gain performance experience and community service hours. Coordinate other student community service opportunities (example: volunteers for DSO Children's Concerts).

Enrichment Coordinator –

Help teachers schedule music professionals to visit BHMS for enrichment performances or clinics with music students. Give students exposure to new music, new ideas, and new mentors to expand their music experience.

Bake Sales – Jane Owens Chairman

Coordinate parents to bake and sell goodies after school every Wednesday. This is PAB's only fundraising activity. Parent bakers and sellers work once or twice per year.

Concert Programs – Jennifer Simpson Chairman

Creates program for each concert. Obtains information from music teachers. Works with office for proofing. Coordinates committee to xerox copies and fold programs.

Bulletin Board –Open

Create and update the music bulletin board located outside the orchestra room. Keep the students up-to-date on local performances, concerts, camp opportunities. Post music information and photos from field trips & BHMS concerts.

Website Manager – Melody Peterson

Maintain and update PAB web site.
